Laborer	17.99/hour	growth 11%*	37,430.**/yr
Painter	17.84/hour	growth 20%*	37,100.**/yr
Masons	21.19/hour	growth 34%*	44,080.**/yr
Electrician	29.04/hour	growth 20%*	60,400.**/yr
HeavyEquip.	21.49/hour	growth 11%*	44,700.**/yr
Plumber	29.87/hour	growth 21%*	59,321.**/yr
Carpenter	21.11/hour	growth 24%*	43,908.**/yr

* Expected Growth rate is from 2012-2022

** Annual income is base on 40 hours 52 weeks/year with no overtime. During peak season, overtime is expected and periods of lay-off are expected during the winter months for some occupations.

Did you know?

- ◆ Apprenticeship—earn money while you are learning your trade
- ◆ The starting wage is around \$16/hour and opportunity to make up to \$40/hour.
- ◆ Traditional female occupations requiring no degree pay \$0.72 for every \$1.00 that men earn in male dominated occupations.
- ◆ 83% of working women work in traditional occupations (no Bachelor’s degree) pay less than \$30,000/year.
- The average full-time working woman will lose \$460,000 in wages over a 40-year period due to the wage gap.
