

## Did you know?

- Apprenticeship—earn money while you are learning your trade
- The starting wage is around \$16/hour and opportunity to make up to \$40/hour.
- Traditional female occupations requiring no degree pay \$0.72 for every \$1.00 that men earn in male dominated occupations.
- 83% of working women work in traditional occupations (no Bachelor's degree) paying less than \$30,000/year.
- The average full-time working woman will lose \$460,000 in wages over a 40-year period due to the wage gap.
